About the Project

MusEducate is a European project funded under the Erasmus+ Programme, aiming to empower adult learners through innovative educational approaches that integrate music, creativity, and inclusive learning practices.

The project brings together a diverse partnership of organisations across Europe, working collaboratively to enhance adult education by developing engaging methodologies, fostering creativity, and promoting lifelong learning opportunities.

MusEducate focuses on:

- Promoting inclusive and accessible adult education
- Enhancing creative and cultural skills through music-based learning
- Supporting adult educators with innovative tools and methodologies
- Strengthening collaboration among partners and stakeholders
- Encouraging active participation and engagement of adult learners

Through a collaborative and research-driven approach, the project aims to create impactful educational resources tailored to the needs of adult learners across Europe.



Objectives

The main objectives of the MusEducate project are to:

1. Enhance digital and storytelling skills of adult learners (25–65), including low-skilled adults and rural professionals, through the creation of gamified digital heritage narratives.
2. Increase civic engagement and community ownership of cultural heritage by involving local residents in workshops, pilot activities, and museum-based events.
3. Promote understanding of cultural heritage and sustainability through digital storytelling and a dedicated MOOC for museum professionals and adult learners.
4. Develop innovative educational resources, including a multilingual digital platform, positioning rural museums as inclusive hubs for adult learning.

First Transnational Project Meeting (TPM) – Athens, Greece

The first Transnational Project Meeting (TPM) of the MusEducate project took place in **December 2025 in Athens, Greece**, marking the official launch of the project.

During the meeting, partners had the opportunity to:

- Present their organisations and expertise
- Discuss the project's objectives, structure, and expected outcomes
- Clarify roles, responsibilities, and timelines
- Align on the implementation of the first work package activities

The meeting was highly productive and laid a strong foundation for effective collaboration and successful project implementation.

Project Highlights

Successful Brainstorming Event

A key milestone of the project was the organisation of the **brainstorming event**, which was completed with great success. Partners actively contributed ideas, shared expertise, and explored innovative approaches to integrating music into adult education.

The event fostered creativity, collaboration, and a shared vision for the development of the project's upcoming activities and outputs.

Large-Scale Survey – Ongoing Completion

The project is currently **concluding the large-scale survey phase**. Each partner country is responsible for collecting **at least 100 responses from adult learners**.

The aim of this survey is to:

- Identify the needs, interests, and challenges of adult learners
- Gather insights into learning preferences and barriers
- Provide evidence-based input for the development of project outputs

Following the completion of the survey:

- **A national report will be produced by each country**

Looking Ahead

Building on the progress achieved so far, the next steps of the MusEducate project include:

- Conducting **focus groups** with stakeholders and adult learners
- Carrying out **desk research** to complement survey findings
- Analysing collected data to inform the development of educational materials
- Moving forward with the design of innovative learning resources

These activities will ensure that all project outputs are grounded in real needs and supported by solid research.

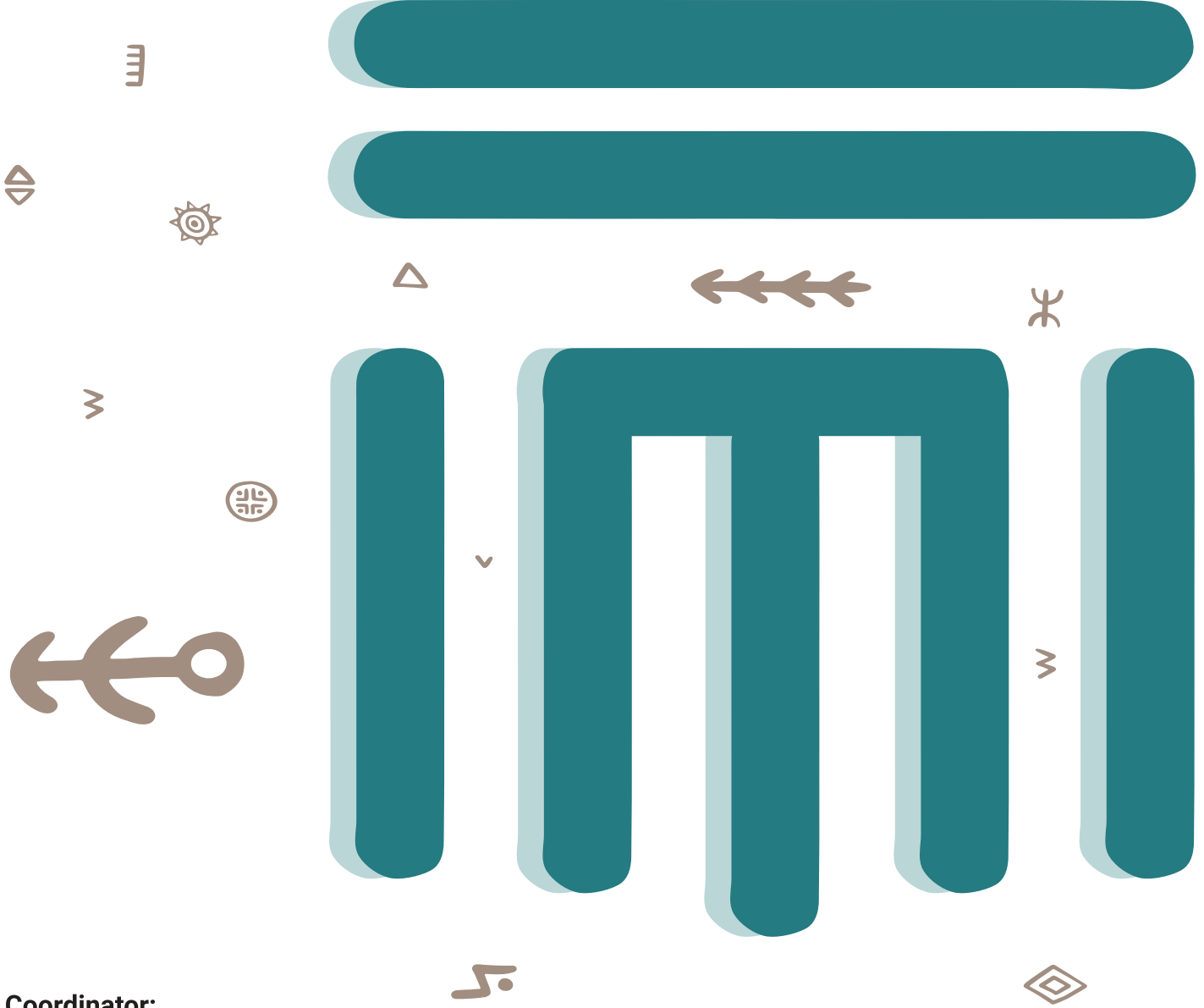
